Need help with travelling to work?

WorkWise may be able to help you.

WorkWise TravelCard

Up to a months free public transport ticket is available to eligible applicants to travel to interviews, training or first month in employment or education.

WorkWise Wheels

Up to a six month hire to buy bicycle scheme with equipment is available to eligible applicants to travel to employment or training.

Scooter Commuter

A six month loan of a 50cc scooter to enable eligible applicants travel to employment or training is available complete with insurance, training, breakdown cover provisional license and personal protective equipment.

Sustrans and the National Cycle Network (NCN)

National Cycle Route 5 (NCR5) between Connah's Quay and Chester is an 8 mile traffic free railway path for cyclists, walkers and wheelchair users. The route was developed by Flintshire County Council and Cheshire County Council and runs along the former Mickle Trafford freight line and is part of NCR 5 between Holyhead and Chester. The section of NCR 5 between Connah's Quay and Flint follows on road Regional Cycle Route 89 (RR89) runs between Hawarden Bridge and Chester for over 6 miles and follows the north bank of the River Dee. This route links into Queensferry and Saltney, via the footbridge at Higher Ferry. Following the canal through Chester links NCR 5 and RR89 to make an excellent circular route. Both NCR 5 and RR89 provide excellent links into the Deeside Industrial Park and other employment centres in the area so that commuting by bike is a real opportunity.

Smart Bus Stops

Traveline Text Service - To use this service simply type the bus stop code (as indicated) as a text message on your mobile phone and send it to 84268. You will receive a text message back listing the next 3 bus services from the stop. Standard text message charge applies.

The Shuttle gets you there!



The shuttle is a commuter service designed to get you to and from work quickly and comfortably with the flexibility of a pick up when you want.

It can pick you up from any of the following locations and take you to work at Deeside Industrial Park: Flint, Connah's Quay, Shotton, Buckley, Ewloe, Holywell, Hawarden, Queensferry, Mancot, Sandycroft.

The Shuttle is also now operating Monday to Friday in Chester, including pick ups at Chester City, Blacon, Saughall, Saltney, Lache and Handbridge.

To use the Shuttle, all you need to do is register, which is free. You can register by calling 08708 50 51 55 or online at www.theshuttlebus.com

This service is available from 05:20 – 24:00 7 days a week. Whether you work shifts, part-time or normal office hours, there is a shuttle on call to get you there. **NB: Chester Shuttle Service does not operate at weekends.**

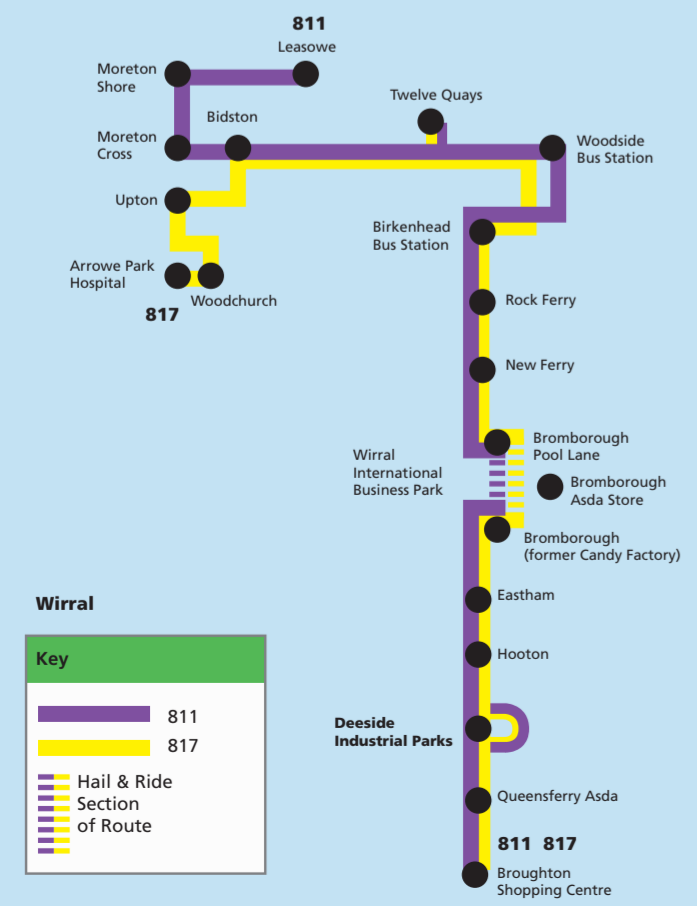


Are you a resident of Wirral?

Need to get to work at Deeside Industrial Park but there is no bus route nearby?

Routes 811 from Leasowe and 817 from Arrowe Park run hourly until mid morning and again from mid afternoon.

How to get to Deeside Industrial Park

From Birkenhead/Wirral
You can use the 811/817 services or catch the train to Chester and pick up the Shuttle (pre-book) at Chester Bus Exchange. Travel from Upton or Heswall railway stations to Hawarden Bridge or Shotton railway station. Cycle and Footpaths are available from here to all 3 zones.

From Chester
Pick up the shuttle (pre-book) at Chester Bus Exchange or use the National Cycle Network Routes 5/89.

From Ellesmere Port
111 bus service from Ellesmere Port to Deeside (not a frequent service).

From Flint/Shotton
Pick up the Shuttle (pre-book) in Flint/Shotton or use the National Cycle Network Route 5.

From Mold
111 bus service from Mold towards Ellesmere Port (not a frequent service). All services alight at zone 1, some services also alight at zone 2, check for details.

From Wrexham
Travel by train to Hawarden Bridge Station (not a frequent service). Cycle and Footpaths are available from here to all 3 zones. Travel by train to Shotton Station and pre-book the shuttle. Cycle and Footpaths are available from here to all 3 zones.

Cycle/Walking Information

Shotton Station to Zone 1 – approx 27mins cycling/38 mins walking
Shotton Station to Zone 2 - approx 10 mins cycling/15 mins walking
Shotton Station to Zone 3 - approx 14 mins cycling/20 mins walking

Deeside Industrial Park is approx 2 miles from Shotton, 3 miles from Connah's Quay or 6 miles from Chester using NCR5. Or 6 miles from Saltney and 8 miles from Chester using RR89.
