Ness Botanic Gardens

Set on the banks of the River Dee, enjoy breathtaking views across to North Wales on this circular walk around Ness Botanic Gardens.

Take a stroll down Denhall Lane towards the vast expanse of salt marsh in the Dee Estuary. On clear days you can enjoy marvellous views across to North Wales including the Clwydian Hills.

The marsh attracts a wide variety of bird life, look out for Widgeon and Teal on the marsh pools and the ever-increasing numbers of Little Egrets spreading their range northwards into Britain.

Finally, the walk takes you through Ness village with its pretty cottages constructed on local sandstone foundations.

The map for this walk is OS Explorer 266 Wirral & Chester.

Distance	5km (3 miles)
Time	Allow 1 – 2 hours
Difficulty	Easy
Landscape Quality	Level terrain; tarmac roads, gravel and earth tracks
Livestock	None

1. From the car park turn right onto Neston Road, cross the road to pavement (no dropped curb).
2. Take the next road to the right onto Denhall Lane.
3. Turn right at t-junction and continue along marsh edge.
4. Turn right onto public footpath towards Ness.
5. Turn right onto Well Lane.
6. Turn right onto Neston Road back to Ness Gardens car park.
